

**Imperial Club**  
Resident Visitation Policies  
Effective 1/2023, until changed

(material changes will be posted in conspicuous areas of the Imperial Club ALF)

These policies are for visitors to ALF residents of Imperial Club.

## **VISITORS**

Visitors MUST...

1. Undergo screening, including answering a questionnaire and having their temperature taken. If a visitor's temperature exceeds limits (see screening form) or if the visitor answers any screening question which Imperial Club, in its best opinion and with consideration for compliance with CDC guidelines, indicates the visitor may pose a risk to residents, staff, or other visitors, the visitor will be denied further entry and will be requested to leave. (Infection control)
2. Undergo education policies for visitors, such as being educated by entrance staff or reading or watching infection control information provided by Imperial Club. (Education)
3. If required by Imperial Club, properly wear a face mask at all times and perform proper hand hygiene upon entry and upon request, and at any other reasonable time when needed. Not all face masks are permitted, three-ply types and others permitted by AHCA will be required. (Infection Control/PPE).
4. Visitors will not be required to show or provide proof of vaccination or immunization status.
5. Be a visitor authorized by the resident(s).

## **OTHER RESTRICTIONS**

1. Occasionally, due to our ability to screen and distance visitors, visitation may not be available. This will mostly be during emergencies, certain overnight hours when staff is unavailable to admit visitors, or special situations. Imperial Club will make diligent efforts to provide visitation whenever possible.
2. Should there be more visitors to the community than can reasonably be screened, distanced, or otherwise more than can be handled (such as fire department occupancy restrictions), this community may limit the number of total visitors to the building at any given time until adequate space is available.
3. The community reserves the right to refuse any visitor who does not exercise good COVID-safe practices or judgment, or who otherwise does not follow the rules and regulations set forth by the community, or who harasses or otherwise interferes with other residents or the performance of their staff with the functions of the ALF. The resident may still be permitted other visitors.

## **VISITATION AREAS**

Visitation areas are:

- The resident's apartment, if the resident allows visitors into their apartment
- The pool area (unless a function is scheduled in that area and space is not available)
- Activity room (when available), and
- Other areas of the apartment community when made available

## **OTHER INFORMATION**

1. Residents and visitors are welcome to have consensual physical contact. The resident shall retain the right to have physical contact if they so choose.
2. Residents may have visitors for an extended period of time. There are no hourly restrictions (i.e. two hours at a time). Residents may ask their guests to leave at any time for any reason. Visitors are not permitted to live or reside or stay overnight on the premises without written permission from Imperial Club's Executive Director.
3. Residents may have multiple visitors at one time – there is no set maximum number of visitors, subject to any safety requirements (such as fire department occupancy requirements) and the ability of Imperial Club's staff to still perform the functions of the ALF (such as assistance with ADLs). Residents may be required to visit with their guests in other locations on the premises (such as the pool area or family room) should there be too many people in their apartment at any given time for the ALF to perform its functions or for safety, as determined by Imperial Club staff or authorities having jurisdiction.
4. The person(s) responsible for staff adherence to visitation policies and procedures is:  
Administrator/Nursing Director.

**THESE POLICIES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.** Imperial Club reserves the right to restrict entry to any visitor as needed to protect persons or property. Adherence to these policies shall in no way imply a guarantee of use or fitness for entry as a visitor. Imperial Club reserves the right to alter or cease visitation immediately should community spread or other significant detrimental conditions arise that would pose a substantial risk to residents or staff, to the limits approved by law (SEE SB 988 FOR CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH A RESIDENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO HAVE A VISITOR BEYOND THESE SITUATIONS)
